# Harm Reduction Kit

We are sharing independent examples from selected hospital sites for the purpose of providing insight into how different sites treat substance use disorder. Please note CA Bridge is not responsible for the content of any site examples, and we do not formally recommend them as best-practices.

Whenever possible, harm reduction measures should be provided to patients. In addition to naloxone, harm reduction can include safe consumption supplies. Highland General Hospital includes the following items in their safe consumption kits. Individual sites may choose to develop their own kits and further their harm reduction offerings. Include information about local syringe exchange programs, fentanyl testing, and safer drug use. ## Safe injection kit

Include informational pamphlets or flyers with local Syringe Access Services locations, phone numbers, hours of operation, as well as information on safer drug use.



1 sharps container containing all of the following:

- 6 alcohol prep pads
- 1 - 10 pack bag of 1 mL sterile syringes
- 4 cooker basins
- 4 tourniquets
- 2 bags of cotton balls
- Fentanyl test strips

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
